



- The NMC assists unit leaders by helping scouts and families with no Scouting background understand how to participate more fully





WHY DOES MY UNIT NEED NMCs?

- Units benefit having more people involved.
- Units loose a high percentage of families soon after joining
- Allows for continuous engagement of scouts and families in the programs
- Helps make connections and answer questions

NEW MEMBER COORDINATOR

- NMC is a registered Scouter with the registration code for this position is "NM"
- NMC counts as a committee member position
- This helps the unit meet the minimum committee member requirements at time of charter/recharter





- The NMC is a FUN and engaging position
- It forms relationships between the unit and new members and their families
- Fits every type of unit, at every age level and in every program
- It is a visible and easily identifiable at unit gatherings with their BSA "Welcome" logo





Camp Wyandot features a 23-acre lake with an island connected by a peninsula, a best-in-class climbing tower and high ropes course, and 16 beautiful rustic campsites. Camp Avery Hand is home to a dozen camping sites, and cabins available to families and unit that sleep four to 32 people! Recent improvements in 2017 include a stunning renovation to the Avery Hand showerhouse, and a brand-new Human Foosball Court.
