Time-Bound

Define a Start and End or length of time

Length: This depends on type of unit

Packs may want to focus on a full year

Troop may want to focus on a 6 month plan to match SPL term

When does plan period start???

September before new Cubs or February before Arrow Crossovers

January to December,

June to May

September to August

It does not matter, just define the time frame that works for your unit.


**** Can only upload 1 file, would need to put Application, Background form and YPT certificate in a single file like a zip file

Red alerts will stop from completion.
Yellow will not stop from completion but will hold up final approval at council.



Yellow alerts can be resolved by uploading copy of YPT certificate or CBC authorization form.

When ready Proceed to Payment.






\$1.00 Fee for eCheck 3% Credit Card Fee

Payment and Confirmation

During this process you have the ability to verify all fees and choose your payment option. The payment option is Check (\$1 fee), Credit Card (3% fee) and Pay at Council. If you pay at council, you will need to provide a form of payment to the local council in order to register your unit. Once you have chosen your payment option, click the Pay and Post Renewal button.



Tip:

- Add members via an on-line invite or submit all application forms downtown before starting
- Check email address of Executive Head, Charter Org Rep, Committee Chair, Cub or Scoutmaster
- Review everyone's Youth Protection Training status now
- Dual memberships, call the other unit to confirm who is going to pay for the person
- Start your internal process today (collecting fees, etc.)
- Plan to have all information before Thanksgiving or earlier.
- Plan to file before the end of November, don't wait to file on the due date
- Recharter 2.0 Starts October 15th Final Due Date December 10th








