LEC MBC Online Renewal

The Lake Erie Council MBC Renewal Process is done entirely using online resources. It begins with each MBC receiving an individualized email from our <u>MBCRenewalsLEC@gmail.com</u> account.

This email will contain general instructions and a custom link (using a tinyURL.com address). This link will take you to a Google Form that is prepopulated with your personal information and the merit badges for which you are listed as being a counselor.

Please check all the information in this Google Form for being correct and review all your merit badges. You need to Drop any badges that you no longer want to counsel. You **cannot** Add any merit badges via this process. If you want to Add badges you need to fill out the LEC MBC Application and send it to the office for processing.

Once you complete your Google Form you will receive a confirmation email that your responses have been recorded.

If you counsel a merit badge that needs specific certifications, copies of those must be submitted to the <u>MBCRenewalsLEC@gmail.com</u> address.

Your YPT must be current and you will need to complete a background check authorization form if you did not recharter with a unit.

This year's renewal will close on 1-Jul-2023. Anyone not renewing by that date will be dropped as an MBC and have fill out a new MBC application.

Merit Badge Counselor Renewal

To keep our Council records accurate, Lake Erie Council is sending out a yearly notice to confirm your designated Merit Badges and contact information to ensure the Merit Badge Counselors list is accurate and up to date. Per the BSA Guide to Advancement we are required to renew counselors on an annual basis. Even if you just applied to be a counselor you are receiving this request since we are processing over 700 renewals and we want to make sure that we have renewal records for everyone.

Please note that your contact information will have restricted access

All the LEC Merit Badge Counselors are also now listed in Scoutbook which affords the units another way of finding MBCs for badges and even connecting their Scouts to counselors so that work on a badge can be recorded and approved in Scoutbook.

The Scouts depend on you and your support and willingness to help them with their achievements to eam Merit Badges.

Below is your custom link to the online renewal form. Please click on the link and verify your contact information as well as your merit badges. Any contact information that you update and/or confirm on this form should also be corrected in my.scouting if there is a discrepancy by yourself.

You have the option to renew or drop only. If you wish to add additional merit badges, you will need to submit the standard Merit Badge Counselor Application separately. To Drop a badge just click the Drop check box next to the badge that you want to drop. If you want to stop being a Merit Badge Counselor, just drop all your badges and we will remove you from the master list.

If any of your merit badges require additional certifications, they **must** be emailed to <u>MBCRenewalsLEC@gmail.com</u> as part of the renewal process. If additional certifications are required and are not submitted, the merit badge will not be renewed. The certifications for each badge requiring them are listed in this document <u>https://tinyurl.com/mruszyyy</u>. Any certificates must be current when you submit your renewal.

Basic Information on what to for renewals including reminder of the merit badge program, how to renew/drop/add badges, youth protection renewal, submitting additional certifications for certain badges, and background check information. One thing that we have established is a MB certificate list for the MBCs that have the current training as stated for the aquatics, shooting sports, and climbing merit badges for which they are registered. If the training is valid, the certificate does not need to be resent since we have the current training on file.

You are also required to be familiar with the current requirements for all merit badges that you counsel. Please review the requirements for a badge before starting a session with a Scout. Merit Badges that had requirements updated in 2023 are listed here: <u>https://www.scouting.org/skills/merit-badges/all/</u>.

Additionally, please check the date that your Youth Protection Training (YPT) expires and make sure you have completed the **current** YPT training. Along with YPT training, Merit Badge Counselor training is available online. Training can be accessed at <u>https://my.scouting.org</u>.

The expiration date of your current YPT is: 11/27/2023.

Your YPT must be current for you to be listed on the LEC master list and in Scoutbook. Any counselors with expired YPT are removed from our monthly updates to the lists posted on the LEC web site. Scoutbook automatically does not list any MBC with expired YPT when units look for counselors. Also, if your YPT is expired by more than 30 days you will be removed from Scouting by the LEC office and will have to re-register for all Scouting positions that you have held.

Merit Badges requiring Certificates or Specialized Training

From the 2021 edition of the Guide to Advancement:

General Supervision Requirements:

 Swimming and watercraft activities must be conducted in accordance with BSA Safe Swim Defense or BSA Safety Afloat, respectively, and be supervised by mature and conscientious adults at least 21 years old and trained in the program applicable. Counselors for merit badges involving swimming or the use of watercraft must be so trained, or use helpers who are.

 All physical activities presented in any Scouting program must be conducted in accordance with "The Sweet Sixteen of BSA Safety." These 16 points, embodying good judgment and common sense, can be found at www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/gss/sweet16.

• CPR instruction, wherever it is required, must be taught by people currently trained as CPR instructors by a nationally certified provider, such as the American Red Cross, the Emergency Care and Safety Institute, or the American Heart Association..

The following merit badges have special qualifications or certifications for either the merit badge counselor or the supervisor of certain activities that may be involved. Counselors and advancement administrators should consult the merit badge pamphlets for details and to maintain awareness of changes and updates as pamphlets are revised.

Climbing All climbing, belaying, and rappelling exercises and activities must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult rock-climbing instructor, age 21 or older, who has completed BSA Climb On Safely training and who understands the risks inherent to these activities. Training as a BSA climbing Level 2 Instructor is highly recommended. Someone with certification in First Aid/CPR/AED from the American Red Cross (or equivalent) must be present at these activities. Current policies are found in the *Guide to Safe Scouting* at www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/gss/gss0/#d and supersede any other publications or literature.

Snow Sports. Activities in the field must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult 21 years or older who is committed to compliance with BSA Winter Sports Safety. Current policies are found in the *Guide to Safe Scouting* at <u>www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/gss/gss12/#b</u>.

The qualifications below for aquatics-related merit badge counseling and supervision not only assist in managing risk, but also give counselors credibility. Current policies are found at www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/gss/gss02 and supersede any other publications or literature.

Canoeing. Those supervising canoeing activities must have either BSA Aquatics Instructor or Canoeing Instructor certification from the American Canoe Association, American Red Cross, or equivalent; OR local councils may approve individuals previously certified as such or trained by an instructor so qualified.

Kayaking. Those supervising kayaking activities must have formal training in kayaking and paddle craft instruction, evidenced by either BSA Aquatics Instructor or Paddle Craft Safety Instructor certification, or kayaking instructor certification from the American Canoe Association, British Canoe Union, or American Red Cross, or equivalent; OR local councils may approve individuals previously certified as such or trained by an instructor so qualified.

Lifesaving. Demonstrations or activities in or on the water must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult, age
