Using the same curriculum as the Boy Scout program, all Scouts BSA troops will run the same Scouting program, earn the same merit badges, and be able to achieve the same ranks, including the prestigious Eagle Scout rank. Importantly, Scouts BSA troops will be single gender – all-girl or all-boy – because the BSA recognizes and celebrates that boys and girls develop differently, and there are times that single-gender learning is the most appropriate. You do not have to retake the training when the March 1, 2019 course is released.
