- Ensure Roster Accuracy.
 - All new member applications have been submitted to Lake Erie Council **prior** to submitting the recharter.
 - Pay close attention to Charter Organization Representative (COR) and Institutional
 Head (IH) changes. These must be done before submitting the charter.
 - o All members with multiple registrations have been confirmed and marked correctly.
 - o Contact information for all members is up to date.
 - Ensure each member has the correct email. This is where they will receive notifications to renew their membership with the BSA starting in 2024.
 - All Scout Life subscriptions have been confirmed.
 - There are at least 5 youth on the roster.
 - All the required positions are filled.
 - Cub Scouts: 1 Charter Organization Representative, 1 Committee Chair, 1
 Cubmaster, 2 Committee Members, and 1 Den Leader.
 - Scouts BSA: 1 Charter Organization Representative, 1 Committee Chair, 1
 Scoutmaster, and 2 Committee Members.
 - Venturing: 1 Charter Organization Representative, 1 Committee Chair, 1 Advisor, and 2 Committee Members.
- All leaders have a current, unexpired Youth Protection Training.
- There are no warnings or errors.
- The recharter document has been signed (manually or electronically) by the Charter Organization Representative (COR), Executive Officer, or Council Unit Representative (CUR).
- Forward the signed PDF of the recharter to <u>recharter@lecbsa.org</u>
- Payment method has been selected.
 - Manual Pay: a check has been turned in to the Lake Erie Council Service Center on or before December 8, 2023.
