Standard first aid courses assume quick arrival of advance medical support by professional emergency responders. In the backcountry, such help will be delayed and proper actions by members of the trek are more important. All outdoors people NEED specialized first aid training – training that address all types of backcountry emergencies and which focuses on different care associated with lack of responders. Certification is urged for high adventure treks.

- Victim assessment and urgent care
- First aid techniques for a wide variety of injuries and illnesses.
- CPR and AED training and certification.
- Realistic hands-on scenarios with instructor analysis and group discussion.
- Full color student textbook, multi-media instruction and course notes hand-outs.
